Licensing Options

Operating system platform

If you need PDFlib for a platform which is not listed you must compile it yourself from C source code (check »other« in this case). This option is not available for the PDF import library PDI, and does not apply to IBM eServer zSeries and iSeries platforms. We offer separate versions for these systems (check our Web site). Please contact us if you are interested in platforms which are not listed since we are constantly expanding the list of supported systems.

Server license

The server license is for developers who are working on server applications for use within their own organisation, or developers who are working on server solutions for their customers. CPUs can be accumulated across several machines, but not across several operating systems. For example, if you have five Linux CPUs and five Windows CPUs, you can't use the »10 CPU pack«, must purchase two »5 CPU packs« instead (one for Linux and one for Windows).

PDFlib and the PDF import library PDI are distributed as a single binary package which is fully functional, but displays a demo stamp across all pages unless a license key is applied. According to your order the license key will either enable the PDFlib functionality or both PDFlib+PDI. Note that PDI cannot be licensed stand-alone, but only in conjunction with PDFlib. Please contact us for unlimited PDFlib or PDFlib+PDI server licenses.

Redistributable license

The redistributable license is for developers who want to ship PDFlib as an integrated part of their products. The redistributable license is only available for client products, but not for any server products, i.e., applications which can be accessed by multiple users at the same time. Please contact us for unlimited PDFlib redistributable licenses. Redistributable PDFlib+PDI licenses will be priced like server licenses, but volume discounts can be negotiated, as well as other arrangements for situations not covered by our standard offers.

Updates

An update changes an existing license to the corresponding license class of a newer version. Please supply your license number with all update orders.

- Maintenance updates (e.g., from PDFlib 4.0.1 to 4.0.2) are always included in your license.
- PDFlib 3.x customers can update to PDFlib 4 for 25 percent of the list price for the corresponding PDFlib 4 license class (if available). For example, an update to a single-CPU license will be US-\$ 125. Updates from PDFlib 3.x to PDFlib+PDI are available at 50 percent of the PDFlib+PDI list price.
- Customers who purchased PDFlib 3.x between February 15, 2001 and April 30, 2001 are eligible for a free update to the corresponding PDFlib 4 license class (if available), and can update to PDFlib+PDI for 50 percent of the list price.
- Please contact us for updates of unlimited PDFlib 3.x licenses.

Upgrades

An upgrade changes an existing license to a higher license of the same software version.

- If you add more CPUs to your servers you can upgrade your existing PDFlib license by ordering the required number of CPU packs.
- You can also upgrade a PDFlib license to a PDFlib+PDI license of the same CPU class by paying the difference in price.

Using PDFlib on an ISP's server

If you run your Web site on a server which is hosted by an Internet Service Provider (ISP) your site may be co-located with many other sites on a single server with multiple CPUs. If the server hosts more than 50 domains which do not belong to your organization you may, at your option, choose a different licensing scheme: not the total number of CPUs is relevant for PDFlib licensing, but the number of active IP addresses which point to your own site. For example, under this scheme a PDFlib license for a single IP address would be US-\$ 500. If the ISP obtains a PDFlib license according to the number of CPUs in the server an arbitrary number of ISP customers may use PDFlib on these CPUs.

Maintenance and support contracts

We offer several levels of support contracts which are only available in combination with a PDFlib or PDFlib+PDI license. Support levels differ in duration, communications (e-mail or phone), response time, number of supported platforms, number of developers within licensee's organization, and may include maintenance (minor) or major updates within the duration of the support contract:

Extended source code license

In addition to the above options we offer several extended licenses. These licenses do not include support or updates, but can be combined with Level 3 support:

- PDFlib source code license, US-\$ 15 000:
Unlimited number of CPUs and platforms; includes all maintenance updates; does not include ActiveX/COM source code; products built with PDFlib must not have PDF generation as their main purpose.
- PDFlib+PDI source code license, US-\$ 25 000:
Unlimited number of CPUs and platforms; includes all maintenance updates; does not include ActiveX/COM source code; products built with PDFlib+PDI must not have PDF generation as their main purpose.
- ActiveX/COM source code US-\$ 5 000:
Source code for the PDFlib/PDI ActiveX/COM wrapper.
